Key achievements



Our work keeps people out of hazardous environments. In 2022, Cyberhawk's drone inspections saved our customers over 11,327 days of time spent in hazardous areas - almost a 50% increase over 2021.

9960 miles driven in our electric van

In 2022, Cyberhawk's drone teams saved our customers over 11,327 days of surveying time in hazardous areas - almost a 50% increase over 2021.

6% increase in female representation

Progress in this area was in part thanks to an increased effort to use specific recruitment platforms such as Woman Engineering Society, RightJob and Women in Technology Jobs.

512 days of training completed

Across the company 512 days worth of training was completed, including 98% of Cyberhawk staff undertaking anti-bribery and corruption training

16% decrease in corporate CO2 emissions

We have reduced our yearly corporate CO2 emissions by 16%, well above the target of 5% we set last year according to SBT guidelines. We are aiming become a net zero company by 2050.

40% decrease in equipment incidents

Our teams reduced operational incidents (per 1000 hrs) caused by equipment issues by 40%; a credit to the hard work and diligence of both our equipment technicians and flight teams

100% of our policies reviewed

Every year our HR and Senior Leadership teams review 100% of the company's policies, to ensure the company is staying true to our values, and providing a supportive and inclusive workplace
